**Current Position:** Vice President, Navy-Marine Corps Programs, Lockheed Martin Corp.

**Description of duties:** Steve provides field marketing coverage to our Navy-Marine Corps team and chairs Lockheed Martin's Navy-Marine Corps Customer Focus Team. This Team brings multiple corporate business units together to understand and provide solutions for complex programs and opportunities across the maritime marketplace. Steve manages corporate field offices in Honolulu, HI, Norfolk, VA, Patuxent River, MD, San Diego, CA, and Quantico, VA.

**Experience:** A former career naval officer and an industry executive for the past 9 years, Steve has had extensive managerial experience in a variety of senior leadership positions.

**Military Service:** Steve commanded two helicopter squadrons and served as Executive Officer of USS John F. Kennedy (CV 67). He deployed as Commanding Officer of two capital warships: the amphibious assault ship USS New Orleans (LPH 11) and the aircraft carrier USS Kitty Hawk (CV 63). As a flag officer his assignments included: Senior Naval Officer, SHAPE headquarters, Mons, Belgium; Commander, Fleet Air Mediterranean; Commander, Naval Surface Group Mediterranean; Commander, Maritime Surveillance and Reconnaissance Forces; and Commander, Maritime Air Forces Mediterranean, Naples, Italy. As the first helicopter pilot to command a carrier battle group, he was Commander, Carrier Group Six / USS John F. Kennedy Carrier Strike Group, supporting Operation Nobel Eagle and combat operations in Afghanistan during Operation Enduring Freedom. He was Commander, Navy Personnel Command / Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel and subsequently privileged to serve as the 16<sup>th</sup> Oceanographer/Navigator of the Navy.

**Education:** Steve was graduated from the United States Naval Academy and holds a master's degree from Central Michigan University.

**Professional Affiliations and Accomplishments:** Steve serves as the Naval Helicopter Association's Chairman Emeritus and was Chairman of the Board from April, 2007- May 2013. He also served on the board of directors of the Association of Naval Aviation and is a trustee of the National Naval Aviation Museum Foundation. He is a member of the Tailhook Association and the Surface Navy Association.
